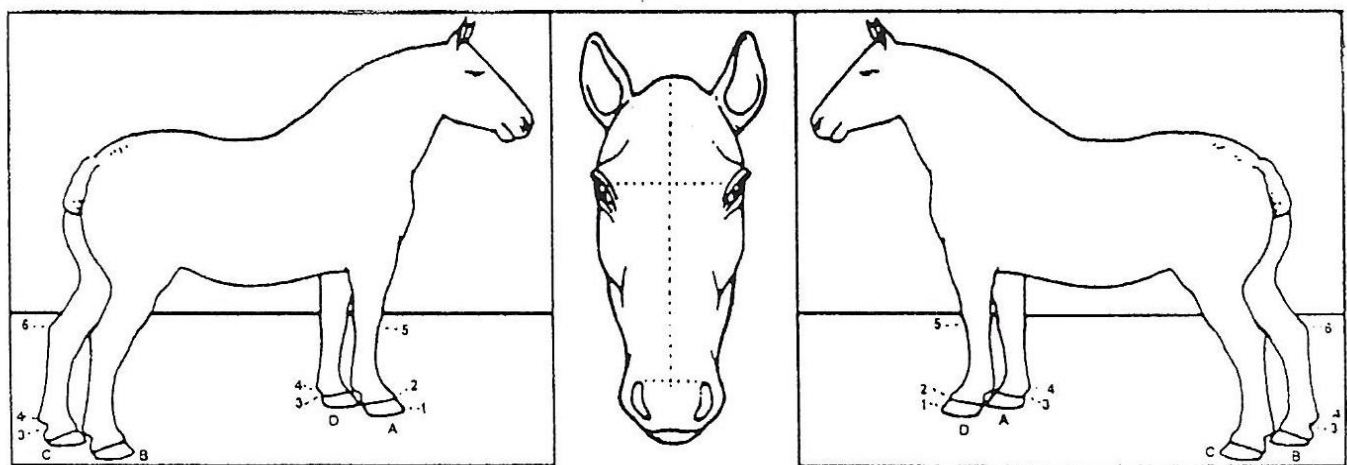

| A – Right fore leg | C – Left hind leg | 1 – Hoof | 3 – Pastern | 5 – Knee |
| B – Right hind leg | D – Left fore leg | 2 – Coronet | 4 – Fetlock | 6 -- Hock |

- Pastern** – A white marking extending to the top of the pastern
Fetlock – A white marking extending to the top of the fetlock
Sock – A white marking extending to midway on the cannon
Stocking – A white mark extending above midway on the cannon
Coronet – A white marking extending to approximately 1" above hoof

- Heel** – A white marking found on the back of the foot
Star – A white mark on forehead, located above the eyeline
Strip – A white mark extending from eyeline toward line above nostrils
Snip – A white or flesh mark between the nostrils or on upper or lower lip
Spots – Pigmented spots located within white

Indicate all dark spots within white
